

How to Play the Game

A sudoku is a grid of 9 squares. Each square is further subdivided into nine cells, as shown below. Some cells in the grid have missing numbers. To solve a sudoku puzzle, each cell in the grid must contain a number between 1 and 9, with the following conditions:

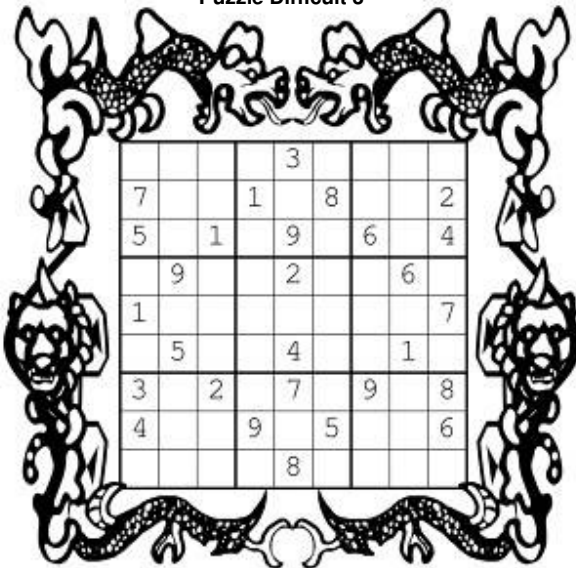
1) Ensure that there are no repeated numbers within the same row.

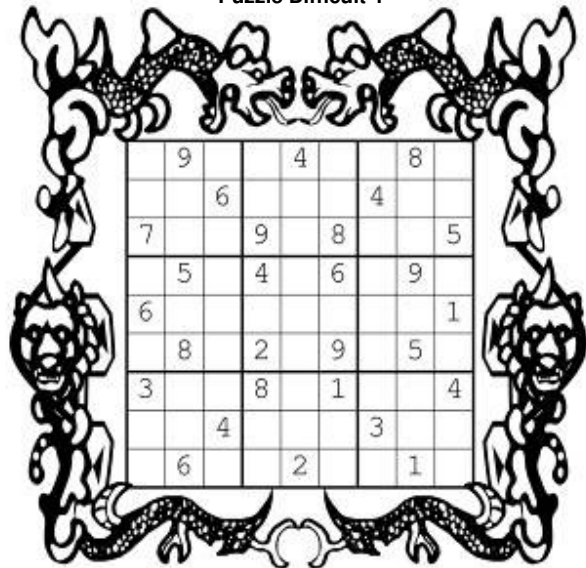
3) Ensure that there are no repeated numbers within the same column.

2) Ensure that there are no repeated numbers within the same 9-cell square.
